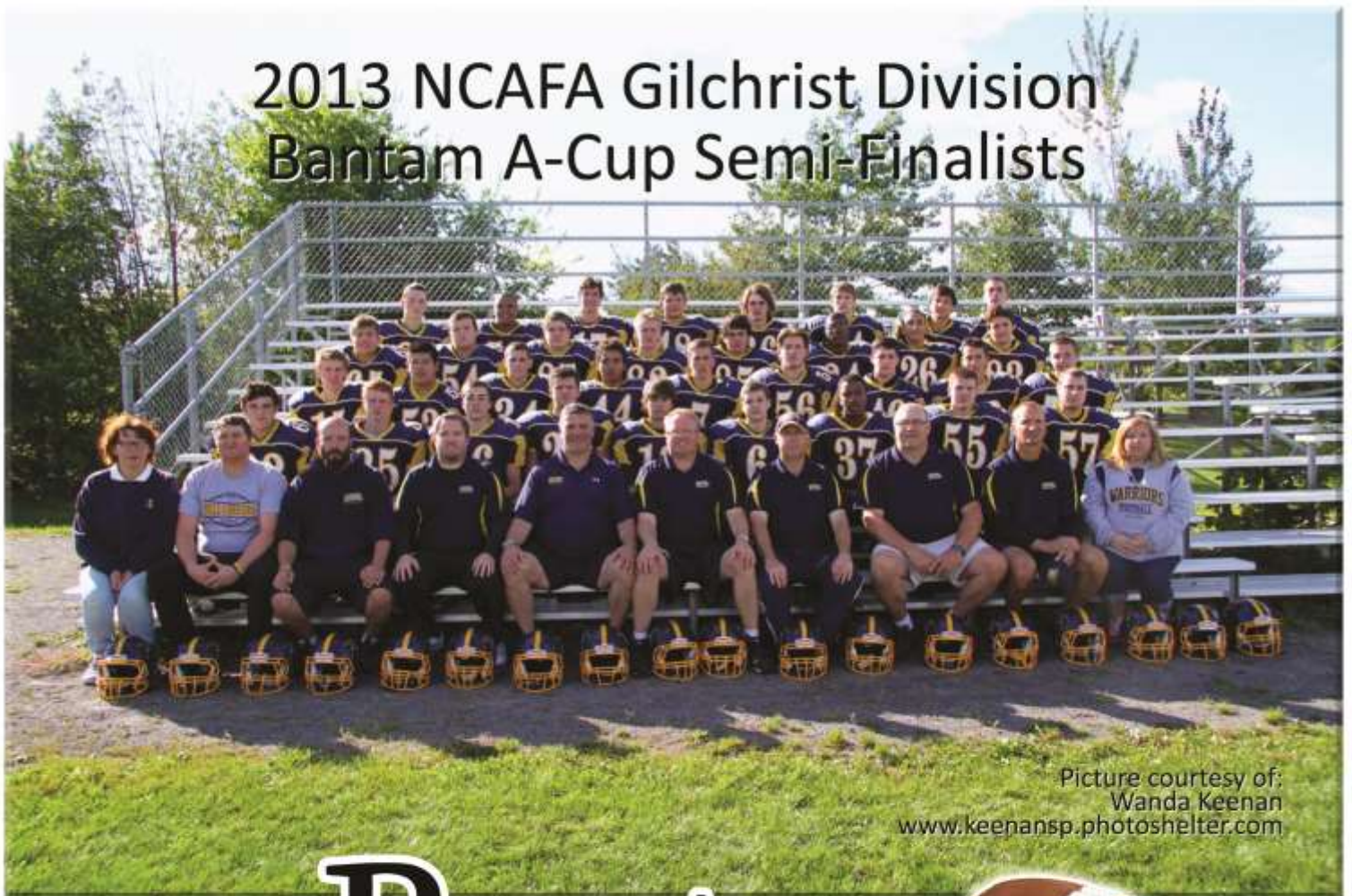

# 2013 Bantam Coach's Message



I know that I have never experienced a season like this one and likely never will again. From practice to practice and certainly, from game to game, we never knew who would be playing next week and in what position. Although we faced a mountain of challenges, we endured and kept on climbing towards our common goal. For me, that goal was to condition our young men physically, mentally and emotionally to embrace our challenges and to see them, not as obstacles but, as opportunities. Despite our rash of injuries, this group of young men surpassed any rational expectations this year and that was truly a reflection on their character and commitment to one another.

There were a number of highlights to the 2013 season. We saw a glimpse of what our team could accomplish early on in our 1<sup>st</sup> match up against the Redskins (who went on to compete in the A-Cup final). Down 14-0 at the half, our boys responded with a level of confidence, pride and determined play that saw us hold Nepean scoreless in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half while scoring 35 unanswered points. In our next 5 regular season games, our dominant defense would only have 27 points scored on them. They finished the season 3<sup>rd</sup> best in the league with only 66 points allowed! Our offense chugged along scoring a total 262 points (2<sup>nd</sup> best overall in the league). In game 6, we dispatched the Raiders (the eventual B-Cup Champions) with a convincing 24-0 romp. An unfortunate injury-plagued 7<sup>th</sup> game gave us our 2<sup>nd</sup> loss and eventually propelled us (do to a league coin toss) to a much tougher playoff path. Game 8, against a very tough Giants squad, saw our defense come up with their 3<sup>rd</sup> shutout of the season while our offense continued to find ways to overcome with a 25 point outcome.

On to the playoffs we went with our 6-2 record to face a rugged but undisciplined 6-2 Mustang team on a slick field and with two defensive players moved over to our offense due to our mounting injuries. The boys could have given in. I'm sure there wouldn't be another team in the league that could have overcome the obstacles that we were facing but our proud boys honoured us all with their determination and unrelenting will. *What a game!* With an amazing 8-0 win, we were on to face Myers in the A-Cup semi-final as one of the top four teams in the league. Looking back, we probably peaked against the Mustangs and we unfortunately lost to the undefeated Riders (the eventual A-Cup winners). However, as I said to the boys after that game, it had been moving to see our boys battle for their teammates, our coaches, our club and our Warriors families and supporters in every drill, every practice and in every game. I know I spoke on behalf of us all when I said we were extremely proud of each and every one of the players.

To our graduating players, I know that you will carry the values and lessons learned about working hard, fair play, team work and focus to face your future challenges with confidence and vigour. To all of our volunteers and my amazing coaches, you know you have the respect of our families and players and my eternal gratitude and thanks.

With a big number of returning players for 2014, I'm looking forward to embracing our challenges again. We will celebrate every moment we are together and overwhelm people with our passion to strive for greatness. **Warriors for Life!** Thank you all,

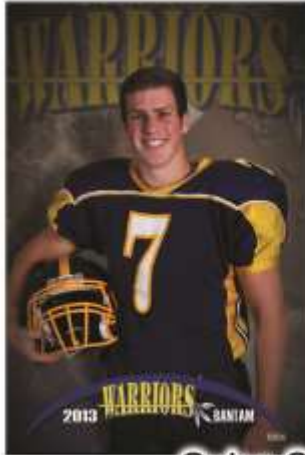

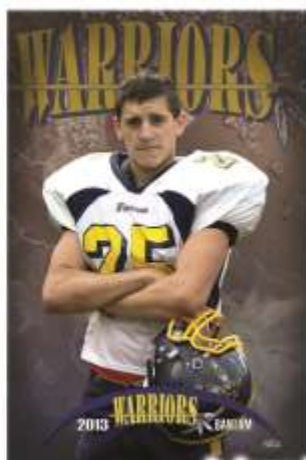
