2015 Mosquito Coach's Message



Congratulations to everyone on this year's mosquito team. Every season is different and presents unique challenges for players and coaches alike. This season was no different. It was certainly a season of ups and downs. I hope each of you has been able to take some time to look back at how much was accomplished this year. I for one am proud of how this team developed week after week accepting every challenge thrown its way.

When I accepted the role of Head Coach this year, I knew we would have our work cut out for us as we were a smaller younger team than in past years. I was however confident that with a group of dedicated coaches and players that came to work, learn and commit themselves, we would be able to compete with any team in NCAFA. When you look back at our season, the statistics truly show how this team grew over the season. In the first 4 games of the season, our defence surrendered an average of 35 points per game. In the last 4 games of the season, this was reduced to a mere 9 points per game average. That is an incredible accomplishment at this level. The offence, young at many key positions, averaged an impressive 20 points per game throughout the season even after moving a number of players to defence and with only 1 member returning last year to the offensive line. They gave us a chance every week.

To have success in anything you do, a strong team around you is essential. Coaching is no different and this year, I was lucky enough to have 2 experienced coordinators, Matt Valois and Geoff Forsythe to help build strong fundamentals within our players. Our assistants were committed and passionate about working together and never doubted the path we took. From the first day of winter work-outs, we focused on a message of playing with discipline and effort and preached the value of hard work at every practice. Every player had a role on this team and leaves this season ready for the next. That is something each and every one of our coaches is proud of. No different than last season, RESPECT continued to be a key message throughout our year. We asked for the players to respect each other, respect the coaches, the game, our opponents and to respect the commitment and hard work it takes to be successful in football and in anything you do. Our players bought in and it showed.

Even after some disappointing early losses, our players were able to keep their confidence and believe in the messages we were delivering. We started to build a reputation throughout the league as a hard-working, never give up, smart and fundamentally sound football team. Our early season challenges showed our players knew they couldn't take any game for granted. No game was over until the fourth quarter and every play mattered. Two early season blow-out losses changed to some closely fought battles mid-season and ultimately a come from behind win against perennial rival Cumberland Panthers in week 7.

As I said in my end of season post game remarks, win or lose it is always tough to walk away from your team after a season wraps up. Each team is unique in its own way and in some way, it can never be repeated. Now that you have had some time away from the game, make sure to remember everything you accomplished this year. Build on your successes and use any disappointment to motivate yourself to get better. Prepare as best you can physically and mentally for next season to give you and your team mates the best chance to succeed.

It was truly an honour to get to know and work with these kids. To those moving up, prepare for an even greater challenge that I know you are ready for. For those returning, you are veterans and the team will require more from you...I know you are ready. Thank you for your trust, your support and your dedication to our club and to its most valuable assets, the players. Enjoy your time away from the game and prepare for next season.
