



2017 Pee Wee Coach's Message



Congratulations to everyone on this year's Pee Wee team. Now that the season has been over for a few months, I hope that you all have taken some time to look back on what you have accomplished. This team continued to grow over the season and our record showed it.

To be successful in anything you do, you have to have a strong team around you. I was extremely lucky this year to have an experienced coaching staff and dedicated team manager. Defensive and Offensive Coordinators, Geoff Forsyth and George Stengel, contributed countless hours on and off the field, adapting to our strengths and emphasizing strong fundamentals to our players. Phil Lavigne, Shayne Forsyth and Hugh O'Toole generously shared their expertise to make sure that our players were ready to perform each and every week. Liam Fleming took on the role as manager and did an excellent job ensuring that our team was well-prepared all season, from the opening day to the banquet and Troy McLeod also took on the crucial role of equipment manager and did a stellar job. This year was also special for me personally as I was able to coach with Paul Gowans, a Warrior teammate of mine from many years ago. Paul's contributions on both sides of the ball, as well as his advice to me as Head Coach, were invaluable.

From our first day at winter workouts, it was obvious that this team had potential. The players had been together for a number of years and this year they had the opportunity to take advantage of moving up to Pee Wee together and to build on last year's strong finish at Mosquito. We opened the season with consecutive shutouts and put 88 points on the board. The other teams in the league took notice right away. This team was strong on both sides of the ball. Our offence averaged over 33 points per game throughout the season and our defence allowed a stingy average of less than 12 points per game. This ultimately led to a berth in the A-Cup Semi-Final, ending in a razor-thin loss by less than one touchdown to the Bengals. It always hurts to finish the season with a loss but looking back, we should take pride in the success this group had.

As I said in my end-of-season post-game remarks, it is always tough to walk away from a team when a season wraps up, regardless of the outcome. Each team season is unique in its own way and in some way, it can never be repeated. Make sure to take time and reflect on what you all accomplished this year. Build on your successes and use it for motivation, not just for the next football season, but also for whatever challenges you decide to take on next year.

It was my privilege to get to know the players, staff and parents of the 2017 Pee Wee team. To those of you moving up to Bantam next year, prepare to be challenged. Work hard and you will be ready. For those of you returning to Pee Wee, you are now veterans and the team and coaching staff will look to you for leadership on and off the field. I know you will all be ready.
