2023 Mosquito Coach's Message



I had the privilege of serving as the Head Coach of this year's Bell Warrior Mosquito team. This marked my 18th year of involvement with the Bell Warriors in some capacity, either as a player or coach, and it feels like this club has been a part of my family for as long as I can remember. With that said, I can honestly say that I have never been prouder of a team than I am of this year's Mosquito squad.

Our team wasn't blessed with elite size or speed. We had one of the smallest rosters in the league with only 24 total players, and many of our players had never played tackle football before. We endured a number of injuries which forced kids to learn and adapt to new positions on the fly. Despite those challenges, our kids put together a remarkable season. We kept finding creative ways to surprise and defeat our opponents, as we tackled, sacked, blocked, ran, passed, and even PUNTED our way to a 4-4 season, and a standout performance in a double OT loss in the "B" Cup playoffs. These kids enjoyed football, they enjoyed practicing and playing together, and they played for one another every day. That makes the season a resounding success no matter what.

I would like to sincerely thank our coaching staff for all their incredible work and dedication. Our staff spent the better part of 6 months working with the kids to develop them into better players and teammates, and our improvement on the field was as much a testament to the coaches as it was to the kids themselves. Our Defensive Coordinator Pat Fleming did an incredible job of assembling a hard-hitting unit that was one of the toughest in the league, and our kids fed off his enthusiasm and energy. Mitch de Savoye worked with each of our defensive position groups (in particular, a standout Defensive Line) and instilled the kids with confidence and grit. The defensive players, and the team as a whole, responded tremendously to their combined approach. Our Offensive Coordinator Mike Wilson worked tirelessly to develop an offence that spread the ball around and maximized our strengths, and the result was 9 different players scoring offensive touchdowns over the course of the year. Jim Wagdin brought years of experience to our team, working with our young Offensive Lineman, and contributing immensely behind-the-scenes. Hugo Aguirre served as both an Assistant Offensive coach and Team Trainer, never missing a practice or game, and taking great care of our kids. Ken Elliot coached on both Offense and Defense, took care of equipment issues, policed the bench on game days; you name it, he did it. He was the backbone of the coaching staff.

A big thank you also goes out to the parents who helped along the way to make our season go so smoothly. Throughout the year, our families continually stepped up to provide support on game days, manning stick crews, setting up game fields, and providing snacks for the kids. Most importantly, the positive energy and support the kids received from our fans on game days was an example for the other clubs across the league. A special thank you goes out to Tracey for all the work she did for our kids. Her contribution to our team (and to the Bell Warriors) was so critical and so appreciated. Thank you to Christine for stepping up as Manager during our season and keeping our team organized and in high spirits. Thank you to my wife Tanya for all her support on game days and her behind-the-scenes help over the course of the year.

I would like the players to know how proud the coaches are of what they accomplished this year. We were dealt a number of obstacles, but the kids met every challenge head on and never wavered. We can't control who our next opponent is, we can't control the game day conditions, and we can't control the calls that go against us. All we can control is our effort and our attitude. You worked hard all year, improved tremendously, and became a true team.

Thank you all for your support and hard work this year, and I can't wait to see you all in 2024.
